HOW GREEN CAMPUS PROGRAMME WORKS?



AWARENESS

This unique and copyrighted program amalgamates various learning methodologies with a Project-based and Cooperative Learning Approach.

After an educational institution registers, we start with a workshop for teachers to make them aware about climate change, provide them with teaching resources and offer them an online course. This boosts the teachers' confidence to take the issue of climate change to their classes and talk about the science, impacts, and solutions.

TEACHERS TRAINING WORKSHOP

It is a half-day workshop on climate change, Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and the six thematic areas of green campus.

EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES

Teachers are provided with Online Teaching Resources like Posters, Infographics, Comics, Workbooks, Booklets.

ONLINE PROGRAMS

Teachers are offered a free Online Certification course on climate change to learn more about the issue and in-hand solutions.
