It is an exciting opportunity for the teachers to immerse themselves in diverse educational environments, culture while learning about innovative practices and hands on-sustainable solutions.

The Teachers' Skillshare Program facilitates a unique opportunity for educators to exchange innovative teaching methodologies and perspectives. By experiencing diverse teaching practices firsthand, participants gain valuable insights that they can apply in their own classrooms, enriching both their teaching and the learning experiences of their students.





HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Teachers' Skillshare Program is a structured educational program being implemented under the Green Campus Programme that allows teachers from one educational institution to learn from another institution about their best practices in the domain of Climate Change, developing a green campus and inculcating sustainable behaviour.

Here is a general overview of how Teachers' Skillshare Program work:



Application

Register school for Green Campus Programme by filling application form & express interest in Teachers' Skillshare Program.



Selection

Applications will be reviewed and selected applicants will be intimated to fill form 2 with the details of visiting teachers and list of 03 states priority-wise.



Matching and Orientation

Applicants will be informed about the host school and upon confirmation an online orientation session will be conducted between the two schools to introduce objectives, expectations, and itinerary.



Collaboration and Skill-sharing

The host school will offer the visiting faculty a final itinerary. During their visit, they'll observe teaching methods, exchange sustainable solutions, and share best practices for integrating environmental education into the curriculum to promote sustainable behaviour among students.



Reflection and Evaluation

After the exchange, participants reflect on their experiences, assessing the program's impact on teaching, student engagement, and environmental awareness over a period of one year. Findings will be shared between the two schools and with The Climate Reality Project India & South Asia.

Knowledge exchange can be done in two modes-

1. **Online-** Teachers can interact via online Medium for -2 hours on any one day agreed and finalized by both schools.

2. **Visit-** Teachers can then visit the Campuses for two days to understand the initiative undertaken by the host school.

Note: All the expenses for travel, accommodation and food of the visiting faculty will be mutually borne by the schools involved.
